Ohio Valley Goodwill Industries Elects Paul C. Davis As New Board Member

Cincinnati, OH · August 11, 2008 · The Board of Directors of Ohio Valley Goodwill Industries Rehabilitation Center, Inc. is pleased to announce that Mr. Paul C. Davis has been elected as a member of the Board of Directors for the local not-for-profit organization. Mr. Davis was elected at the Board of Directors meeting on July 28, 2008. Goodwill's Board of Directors helps to set policy and formulate governance issues and procedures for the organization.

Mr. Davis has over forty years of experience serving as a teacher, educator and administrator for the Cincinnati Public Schools and the Hamilton and Warren County Boards of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities. Davis served in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1959, during which time he spent three years as a Combat Engineer in Germany. Following his military experience, Davis attended Ball State University in Muncie, IN where he graduated with a B.S. in Elementary Education. Later he received his Masters in Education Administration from the University of Cincinnati.

From 1962 to 1971, Mr. Davis served as a Special Education instructor for the Cincinnati Public Schools. From 1971 to 1976, Mr. Davis served as a Supervisor for the school district.

In 1976, Mr. Davis was hired as a Principal for the Hamilton County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (MR/DD) and in 1982, he was appointed as Director of Adult Services. In 1987, he was appointed as Assistant Superintendent for the Board, a position he held until his retirement in 1998. In 2000, he was hired by Warren County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities as their Deputy Superintendent and remained in that position until 2003.

Mr. Davis has served as a board member at "Valued Learning and Teaching," a charter school from 2006 to 2007 and is currently serving as Fiscal Officer of Columbia Township with an appointment from 2008 through 2012. Prior to this elected position, Davis was elected to serve as a Trustee of Columbia Township from 2001 through 2004.

Davis is a 33 year resident of Columbia Township where he lives with his wife Carol. He is the father of two grown daughters and the grandfather of three grandchildren.
