### **Ohio Valley Goodwill Industries Receives \$10,000 Grant to Fund New West Side Rehabilitation Center**

Ohio Valley Goodwill Industries, Inc. in Cincinnati has received a \$10,000 grant from The Greater Cincinnati Foundation (GCF) to fund a program which will provide vocational training and work experience to men and women with severe and profound disabilities who live in Western Hamilton County.

Ohio Valley Goodwill is a not-for-profit organization serving the greater Cincinnati Tri- State Area with vocational training services for people with disabilities and disadvantages. Ohio Valley Goodwill has been serving hundreds of people with disabilities and disadvantages in The Greater Cincinnati Area for over 90 years.

The GCF grant will be used to furnish the newly remodeled facility on Cincinnati's West Side, with an adjustable changing table for toileting services, adjustable work tables, chairs, medication cabinet and

equipment, basic office and classroom furniture, work storage cabinets, appliances needed to furnish a working kitchen, work equipment such as carts, dollies and pallet jacks, TV for recreational /classroom activities, a stationary bike and lockers.

Joseph S. Byrum, President and CEO of Ohio Valley Goodwill, said that “A program on the West Side has been in the planning stages for many years and has finally come to fruition, allowing Goodwill’s outreach efforts to people with disabilities in that area to become a reality, thereby helping to fulfill Goodwill’s mission of service.”
