Ohio Valley Goodwill Announces 2019 CARF Accreditation Survey Results!

Ohio Valley Goodwill is pleased to announce that the organization has completed its 2019 Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) survey review with a very positive outcome. For the sixth consecutive time, Ohio Valley Goodwill attained a perfect survey outcome with no recommendations for improvement. This most recent survey outcome places Ohio Valley Goodwill in a category of distinction that is unparalleled in accreditation standards.

Accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF), Goodwill had previously received five perfect Three Year Accreditation surveys, resulting in zero recommendations; placing it in the top 3% of similar organizations nationally. This level of accreditation is an extraordinary accomplishment and the organization is very proud of the 2019 outcome. The 2019 survey took place from April 24th through April 26th and was a review of Goodwill's comprehensive Employment Services, Comprehensive Vocational Evaluation services as well as its Community Integration programs.

For the seventh consecutive year, Ohio Valley Goodwill has partnered with Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities and local employers to offer its popular Summer Youth Services. During the first week of the service, students attend classes at the organization's corporate headquarters and focus on topics like professionalism, teamwork, business ethics, communication, networking, problem-solving as well as the practical aspects of filling out applications and putting together a resume. The following four weeks of the summer session provide on-site community work experiences at a host of area companies including LeSaint Logistics. Throughout the two summer sessions, Goodwill welcomed more than 100 students into the transition



service designed to provide students with a variety of team building and vocational exploration experiences structured to help them gather information about the world of work.

Worksites are spread across the Greater Cincinnati community and offer the chance for students to fully become engaged in the different aspects that each employment opportunity presents.
