25TH ANNIVERSARY OF FLYING PIG Marathon and Pigabilities 2023!

This year marks the 25th Anniversary of the Cincinnati Flying Pig Marathon and Ohio Valley Goodwill has been along for the ride throughout the Marathon's history. In the year 2000, Goodwill participated in the Relay aspect of the new event as a fund-raiser for the organization. For many years, Team Goodwill participated in the Hope and Possibility event which was a precursor to the now, PigAbilities event, for which Goodwill is the Title Sponsor. PigAbilities is designed to be an event which is fully accessible and welcoming to athletes of all abilities. 2023 will mark the 7th year Ohio Valley Goodwill has been the Title Sponsor of the PigAbilities event and already, Team Goodwill has started their Spring training in preparation for the big day. Taking place the weekend of May 5th-7th this year, the PigAbilities event will welcome athletes on Saturday, May 6th at 12 noon.
